

## Preparation for the Ministry, Pt. 2 Mark 6:7-13



**Deu 17:6** At the mouth of two witnesses, or three witnesses, shall he that is worthy of death be put to death; but at the mouth of one witness he shall not be put to death.



**Deu 19:15** One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.



1 Tim. 5:19 Against an elder receive not an accusation, but before two or three witnesses.

Gen 2:18 And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him.


Ecc 4:9 Two are better than one; because they have a good reward for their labour. 10 For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow: but woe to him that is alone when he falleth; for he hath not another to help him up. 11 Again, if two lie together, then they have heat: but how can one be warm alone? 12 And if one prevail against him, two shall withstand him; and a threefold cord is not quickly broken.

Component 3: The Apostles were STRENGTHENED.




Acts 1:4 And, being assembled together with them, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of




Component 1: The Apostles were SUMMONED.

Component 2: The Apostles were **SENT.** 


Component 3: The Apostles were STRENGTHENED.

Component 4: The Apostles were SPOKEN to.




The work of the ministry is never about us trying to come up w/ our best and brightest ideas.


Preparation for the Ministry, Pt. 2
