

16. PROVERBS 6:12-19 THE DESTRUCTION OF THE WICKED MAN

1. Who he is and what he does.

Proverbs 6:12-19 A naughty person, a wicked man, walketh with a froward mouth. ¹³ He winketh with his eyes, he speaketh with his feet, he teacheth with his fingers; ¹⁴ Frowardness *is* in his heart, he deviseth mischief continually; he soweth discord.

- **Vs 12 – Bad person.**

Naughty – _____ (16 x's!) Devil.

“without profit, worthlessness!”

1 Samuel 2:12 Now the sons of Eli *were* sons of Belial; they knew not the LORD.

2 Corinthians 6:15 And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel?

“wicked” 5x's; “ungodly” 3x's and “evil”

The naughty are affiliated with Satan. Their _____ is **perverse**.

Their mouth: Froward – Perversity; crooked. They have perverse, twisted speech.

Matthew 12:34 O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh.

- **Vs 13 – Bad _____ language.**

Winking eyes / Speaking feet / Teaching fingers.

Notice that this is NOT plain talk! It's not open, honest communication.

- **Vs 14 – Bad agenda.**

(1) Perverse heart = (2) evil planning (“mischief”=“evil” 442 x's) = (3) sowing discord.

Proverbs 16:30 He shutteth his eyes to devise froward things: moving his lips he bringeth evil to pass.

Beware! It's the wicked that buy what this man is selling!

Proverbs 17:4 A wicked doer giveth heed to false lips; *and* a liar giveth ear to a naughty tongue.

WHO are we ultimately being warned away from?

Revelation 13:4-7 And they worshipped the dragon which gave power unto the beast: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who *is* like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him? ⁵ And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and power was given unto him to continue forty *and* two months. ⁶ And he opened his mouth in blasphemy against God, to blaspheme his name, and his tabernacle, and them that dwell in heaven. ⁷ And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations.

Psalms 52:1-5 (David re Doeg the Edomite – pic of antichrist!) Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? the goodness of God *endureth* continually.

² Thy tongue deviseth mischiefs; like a sharp razor, working deceitfully. ³ Thou lovest evil more than good; *and* lying rather than to speak righteousness. Selah.

⁴ Thou lovest all devouring words, O *thou* deceitful tongue. ⁵ God shall likewise destroy thee for ever, he shall take thee away, and pluck thee out of *thy* dwelling place, and root thee out of the land of the living. Selah.

So also, his family!

Romans 3:10-18 As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one: ¹¹ There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God. ¹² They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one. ¹³ Their throat *is* an open sepulchre; with their tongues they have used deceit; the poison of asps *is* under their lips: ¹⁴ Whose mouth *is* full of cursing and bitterness: ¹⁵ Their feet *are* swift to shed blood: ¹⁶ Destruction and misery *are* in their ways: ¹⁷ And the way of peace have they not known: ¹⁸ There is no fear of God before their eyes.



2. His destruction.

¹⁵ Therefore shall his calamity come suddenly; suddenly shall he be broken without remedy.

- The **antichrist**.

Psalm 52:5-9 God shall likewise destroy thee for ever, he shall take thee away, and pluck thee out of *thy* dwelling place, and root thee out of the land of the living. Selah. ⁶ The righteous also shall see, and fear, and shall laugh at him: ⁷ Lo, *this is* the man *that* made not God his strength; but trusted in the abundance of his riches, *and* strengthened himself in his wickedness. ⁸ But I *am* like a green olive tree in the house of God: I trust in the mercy of God for ever and ever. ⁹ I will praise thee for ever, because thou hast done *it*: and I will wait on thy name; for *it is* good before thy saints.

Revelation 19:19-21 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army. ²⁰ And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

- His **followers**.

²¹ And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which *sword* proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

3. Why.

¹⁶ These six *things* doth the LORD hate: yea, seven *are* an abomination unto him: ¹⁷ A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, ¹⁸ An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, ¹⁹ A false witness *that* speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren.

1. Pride. Isaiah 14:12-20
2. Lies. John 8:44
3. Murder. Ditto!
4. Wicked imagination. Gen 3:1-6
5. Wicked running. Rom 3:15; Rev 13:7,15
6. False witness. Rev 13:11-18
7. Sowing discord.

1. _____ family and agenda

John 8:44 Ye are of *your* father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

2. _____ family and agenda

Philippians 1:21 For to me to live *is* Christ, and to die *is* gain.

Colossians 3:1-10 If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. ² Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. ³ For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God. ⁴ When Christ, *who is* our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory. ⁵ Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry: ⁶ For which things' sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of disobedience: ⁷ In the which ye also walked some time, when ye lived in them. ⁸ But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth. ⁹ Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds; ¹⁰ And have put on the new *man*, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:
