4.	 The Acts account of Paul's in Thessalonica. Acts 17:1-9 Thessalonica was a KEY city (a regional seat of power.) Paul's "manner" = Paul's missionary strategy. Vs 3 compare Acts 1:1-3; Luke 24:44.
	• RESULT? The synagogue would Paul had the of a new Vs 4 Those who refused Christ formed the of for the new believers. Vs 5-9 Jews – religious rulers. All the persecution that follows Paul is brought by the Jews. Why? Their synagogues were turning to Jesus!
	 VS 6: What a testimony! Jesus flips the power structures of this world! 2 Corinthians 8:9
	 The Thessalonician disciples convinced Paul and his group to go into hiding. (vs 6) They were smuggled out into a place of safety. (vs 10) They took the rap for Paul. (vs 8) Paul's work in Thessalonica was finished. The missionaries might be driven out, but the church remained, AND they still needed help! Paul wanted to get back but was hindered. 1 Thess 2:17-18 This was so hard on Paul because the church was greatly persecuted. 1 Thess 2:14.

5.	 The Acts account of Paul's ministry in Berea. Acts 17:10-15 Vs 10-12: Notice the same missionary strategy. The Bereans tested everything by Prov 14:15; 1 John 4:1; 1 Thess 5:21; Isaiah 1:18 Vs 14: Here is another <u>biblical approach</u> to leadership development and church discipleship. Silas and Timothy are left to establish the church. KEY: we use the ministry to build MEN. We don't use men to build the ministry.

6. Why we need to study the letters to the Thessalonicians.

False teachers had come and tried to subvert the church – they taught that they had missed the rapture, that they were suffering tribulation, etc... The same thing is happing today!

- We need to stay sharp on Bible prophecy.
- Note the order of the books.
- We need to see how to live Christ before His return for us.
