•	Sorrow in hope vs no hope. For us? Christ Himself is our hope. <b>John 11:26; 14:1-3, 6</b>
	Note: When believers lose loved ones, believers sorrow. <b>John 11:33-35</b>

•	Believe based on the power of Jesus' Vs 14  Do you believe that Jesus rose from the grave? 1 Corinthians 15:1-8
	KEY: Belief in His resurrection is necessary for salvation. Romans 10:8-11
	Did Jesus LITERALLY come back from the dead and come out of His grave? Will His followers? 2 Corinthians 4:14; 15:22-23
	The resurrection from the dead is a biblical certainty! Job 14:13-15;19:23-27; Matthew 22:31-3
	KEY: In the big picture resurrection view, we will be part of one of possible resurrections John 5:28-29; 6:40; Revelation 20:1-6; 1 Corinthians 15:51-58 Those that sleep in Jesus (in faith) = the body is dead. James 2:26 The soul is with Jesus! 2 Corinthians 5:8; Philippians 1:20-24; 2 Corinthians 5:1
	KEY: No believer ever dies alone. Why? God is with them! Psalm 23; Matthew 10:29
•	Believe based on the of the Word of the Lord. <b>Vs 15</b>
•	Notice the rapture  "Prevent" = The dead in Christ rise Vs 16-17  The overall order:  1. Jesus comes back with believing saints. Vs 15. Acts 1:11  2. The Lord descends with declaration – described as 3 sounds.  FIRST, a shout. John 11:43; Revelation 1:14; 4:1; John 5:28  What does He shout? Song of Songs 2:10-13; John 11:43; Revelation 4:1
	SECOND, the voice of the archangel = Michael? Jude 9
	THIRD, the trump of God. 1 Corinthians 15:52; Revelation 4:1
	Notice the rapture Note the pronouns "WE."
	This is called the doctrine of the return of Jesus for His church.  This is an incredible event! <b>1 Corinthians 15:35-57; 1 John 3:1-3</b> HOW? God designed and knew you before He ever formed you. <b>Psalm 139:16; 127:3</b>

•	It's comfort because we know we never a loved one in Christ.  It's comfort to know we will not stay dead. Jesus' resurrection is proof of our future resurrection.
