Justified – It's by God's _____! Romans 3:24; Titus 3:7

Here's the shortcut on this doctrinal term. **Justified** =

Justified – It _____ God everything. John 1:29; Exodus 12:2-7

Jesus HIMSELF was our spotless lamb - made our sacrifice! Revelation 13:8; Romans 5:9

Vs 2-6 describes how a person _____ saved. **Access!** (by grace thru faith)

KEY: a mature proven faith? It is SECURE in the love of God! Phil 2:3; John 15:13

- God's view is that the worst sinner holds all value! *The proof?* Matthew 9:13

3. **Sinners!** Vs 8 – God gave His life showing _____ when we were _____.
Phil 2:1-8

The proof!? Luke 23:34

He loved us wearing a crown of thorns! Gen 3:17-19

4. **Saved!** Vs 9 – God's wrath over our sin was _____ through Christ's shed blood!

5. **Saved!** Vs 10 – In Christ we now have _____ Life! Romans 6:4; Revelation 19:16
